

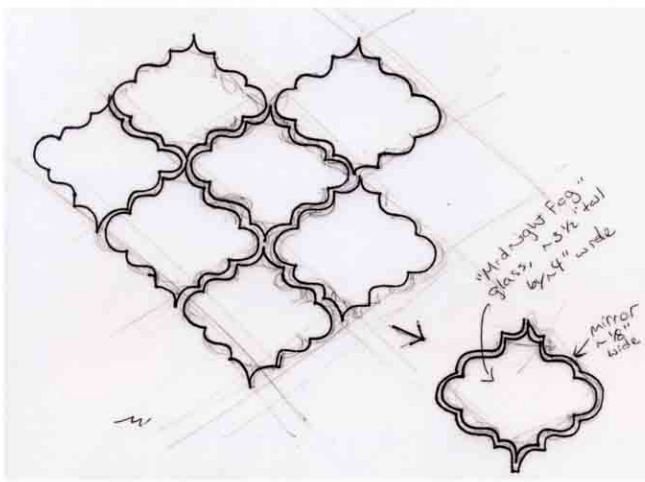
Creating a custom surface:

Once the final design is decided upon, e-mail it to jburnard@msn.com with your request.

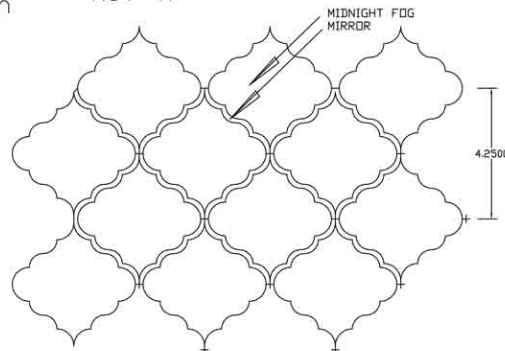

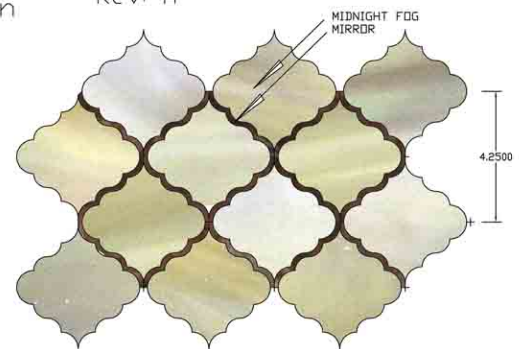
